However, SNBV does want to see that the Candidate is able to manage and implement complex, time-driven, large-scale projects successfully. Therefore, if the lead time of the used reference project is longer, the amount of produced, delivered and installed Passenger Transportation Installations should be increased correspondingly. For example, if the lead time of a project is 3 years instead of 2 years, the number of produced, delivered and installed Passenger Transportation Installations must be 75 instead of 50.</p> <p>On page 28, the sentence 'The Reference Project must include the production, delivery and timely installation of, at minimum, 50 Passenger Transportation Installations, including at least lifts, escalators and moving walks, within a time span of 2 years from the agreement award date to the complete installation of all Passenger Transportation Installations' must be changed to: 'The Reference Project must include the production, delivery and timely installation of, at minimum, 50 Passenger Transportation Installations, including at least lifts, escalators and moving walks, within a time span of 2 years from the purchase order date to the complete installation of all Passenger Transportation Installations'.
