1 GENERAL INFORMATION

1.1 N.V. Nederlandse Gasunie

Gasunie is a European gas infrastructure company. The Gasunie network is one of the largest high-pressure pipeline networks in Europe and consists of more than 15.000 km of pipelines in The Netherlands and Northern Germany, dozens of installations, and approximately 1.300 gas receiving stations.

The annual throughput of gas is approximately 125 billion cubic meters. Gasunie serves the public interest in the markets in which it is active and strives to create optimal value for stakeholders.

1.2 Gas compression units

Gasunie has 21 gas compression units. These units are used to comprise gas to different pressures for transportation in the gas infrastructure.

Spey	1	Ravenstein
RB211-22	3	Ommen
Avon	17	Beverwijk, Oldeboorn, Ommen en Ravenstein

The units have relatively low running hours (less than 500 hours per year). Still Gasunie needs these installations to comprise gas for another 20 years.

Gasunie executes the preventive maintenance by herself. For the corrective maintenance and borescope inspections Gasunie wants a reliable, pro active supplier.

1.3 Scope

The following units are in scope:

- Gas generators:
 - Rolls-Royce Avon
 - Rolls-Royce RB211
- Power turbines (Cooper Bessemer):
 - RT45
 - RT48
 - RT48S
 - RT56
- Gas compressors of Cooper Beesemer
 - RFA
 - RFB (several models)
- Gas generator Rolls-Royce Spey.
- Outer piping:
 - Fuel gas system (turbine meter is excluded)
 - Start system
 - Lubrication and seals, including control.

Gasunie requires the following services at above mentioned units:

- Execution of borescope inspections at Gasunie locations.
- Proper recommendations based on this inspections.
- Repair of the units.
- Consultancy.
- Delivery and stock of spare parts for repairs.
- Reports per milestone.

1.4 Agreement

Gasunie wants a long term agreement for inspection and repair of these units. The units should continue for at least 20 more years (Spey approximately 5 years). This means a cooperation for a long time. Goal is to guarantee the continuation of the gas transport.

Therefore trust, transparency and cooperation are important values for this agreement. Gasunie want to maintain the units against reasonable prices. So service and handling activities as much as is really necessary to guarantee gas transport. Supplier must be capable to advise Gasunie in this matter, so supplier must be a pro active expert.

1.5 Market consultation

Before starting a possible European Tender, Gasunie wants to get an impression of the market. With this consultation Gasunie wants to reach the following goals:

- Informing the market about this possible European Tender;
- Getting an impression of:
 - a) How many suppliers can offer the required services?
 - b) Which of the units can suppliers repair?
 - c) What is important for a long term agreement?
