Question 1

Your document states that:

"The tenderer shall prove that his quality management system meets the requirements of ISO 9001:2015, or an equal system of quality management; scope: the delivery of (bird) radars. If a tenderer is to be qualified for the award of the contract, the tenderer shall, upon written request of the Contracting Authority, submit within 10 working days a valid quality management system certificate, in order to prove that the requirement is met"

We wish to clarify and ask you to confirm that self-declaration of our quality control and customer implementation process will be acceptable, as an alternative to certification *"issued by an independent accredited body"*.

Response of the Contracting Authority

The requirements concerning the quality management system remain unchanged. In the Procurement Guideline (page 17) it is stated that equivalent measures concerning quality management with which the requirements have been implemented may be accepted by the Contracting Authority, provided that this appears from a declaration of an independent accredited body. The Contracting Authority will also accept a declaration that is issued by a governmental body.

Question 2

Do we need to fuse, i.e. show both the Bird Data and the ADS-B data on the three Tablet Displays?
Or will the ATC Tablets only show the ADS-B data and the Bird user Tablet show only the Bird Data?

Response of the Contracting Authority

Requirement is to show ADS-B data to ATC tablets only and bird data to bird control unit tablets only, but preferred to be fused as a layer to be switched on/off with respect to future CONOPS (concepts of operations).
