

Notification: Peer review services: auction design for award of the 700, 1400 and 2100 MHz-bands

Purpose of the notification

The Procurement Office of the Ministry of Economic Affairs and Climate Policy is publishing this notification. The purpose of this notification is to determine whether there are parties interested to carry out the research described below.

Background information

The Ministry of Economic Affairs and Climate Policy is preparing an auction of licenses in the 700, 1400 and 2100 MHz-bands. A third party has been contracted to provide advice on the optimal auction design (model and rules) for this award. The Ministry is now looking for an outside expert to provide peer review services on the work done by the aforementioned third party. The core of the assignment is to provide peer review services that is to provide a critical but also constructive look at the work done by the aforementioned third party and facilitate a choice of auction design by the Ministry that is beyond reproach.

Required skills / experience

- Knowledge and expertise in the field of auction and game theory, and spectrum auctions in particular.
- Experience advising governments on spectrum auctions.
- Experience advising and/or supporting market parties in the preparation and/or execution of spectrum auctions.
