Precise information on deadline(s) for review procedures:

Tenderers will be informed of the award decision or any other decisions regarding this tender procedure - such as exclusion of the tenderer, disregard of a tender, or cancellation of the tender procedure - at the earliest possible opportunity.

If tenderers object to this award decision, they must make their objections known to TenneT within 20 calendar days by serving an application for interim measures before the competent preliminary injunctions court at Arnhem. The above-mentioned term of 20 calendar days shall commence on the day after the date on which TenneT's decision was sent. The term of 20 calendar days must be regarded as a time limit. Upon expiry of this term, TenneT shall consider that it is entitled to finally award the contract and conclude the agreement. If tenderer decides after these 20 calendar days to initiate summary proceedings in connection with TenneT's award decision, TenneT will adopt the position that Tenderer has inadmissible claims.

Tenderers that institute summary legal proceedings are requested to send the TenneT contact person a copy of the draft summons via the messaging module on the Negometrix platform. TenneT has the right to provide a copy of the served summons to stakeholders such as the party or parties provisionally awarded the contract.

Provided that summary legal proceedings are instituted in the prescribed way, TenneT will await the outcome of the proceedings before definitively awarding the contract.

TenneT reserves the right to await the outcome of any appeal before possibly awarding the contract definitively.

If TenneT has notified the tenderer provisionally awarded the contract of the instituted summary legal proceedings, the tenderer concerned will be required to intervene in the legal proceedings, on penalty of forfeiture of the right to take further action against any amended intention to award the contract.

If a tenderer wishes to institute proceedings in a dispute that is not related to stop the tender procedure, the award, or a retender, it must do so no later than 90 days after the dispute arises, but in any event no more than 90 days after the date on which the contract is awarded, unless the dispute is the result of a circumstance which only came to light after expiry of that period and of which the tenderer could not reasonably have been expected to be aware sooner. In the latter case, the period of 90 days will start on the day on which the circumstance in question came to light or on which the tenderer could reasonably have been expected to be aware of the circumstance. The period of 90 days must therefore be regarded as a time limit in this case also.
