One of the main objectives of the OCRE project is to create and further stimulate demand for IaaS+ services in Europe. For this specific objective the EC has made funds available that are to be distributed via the frameworks following this tender. Because of the current absence of demand for IaaS+ services in many lots of this tender it is difficult to predict contract volumes over a period of 4 years, especially since the stimulation of demand in one of the main drivers behind this tender procedure. At the time of publication it is not known in which countries the EC adoption funds are to be spend.

Therefore is is hard to estimate the total spend for this lot. The estimated spend is therefore an estimate only. No rights can be derived from the indicated estimated value.

The tender is divided in 40 Lots, each Lot representing an European country. Estimated value per Lot differs between € 5 and € 150 million Euros over a period of 48 months. Combined over 40 Lots the total value is not expected to exceed € 600 million
