Gasunie together with the Port of Rotterdam are jointly preparing a district heating connection between the existing pipeline “Leiding over Noord” in Vlaardingen and the Uniper power station facility at De Constant Rebecqueplein (CR plein) in The Hague, The Netherlands. This pipeline will fall under the banner WarmtelinQ. WarmtelinQ will transport hot water (118°C) from the heat suppliers to the several heat transfer stations (Dutch: Warmteoverdracht stations). Here the heat will be transferred to connected district distribution grids via plate heat exchangers. After heat transfer, cold water (68°C) will be returned to the heat suppliers where the water will be heated up again. For each heat transfer stations at least 2 plate heat exchangers are needed.

During phase 1 the heat transfer station CR plein, The Hague will be built. In this phase the 2 plate heat exchangers will be required and 1 in the future.

More plate heat exchangers will be required in future phases of WarmtelinQ when more heat transfer stations will be built.

The total number of plate heat exchangers to be purchased under the frame contract is estimated to be about 30 pieces from DN100 - DN300.

Gasunie intends to conclude a framework contracts with one tenderer. This framework contract has an intended term of four (4) years and optional extension of two (2) times four (4) years.

It is important that the framework contract can cover the full duration of the project and that materials do not have to be re-contracted at the end of the project. As the realization of the WarmtelinQ project may span 10 to 12 years, a contract duration for the framework agreement of up to 8 years is too short as re-tendering could mean a break in standardization. Therefore, the framework contract is framed for four (4) years and optional extension of two (2) times four (4) years. The reasoning is that WarmtelinQ is one project that is served by as much standardization as possible. The last extension of 4 years (years 9-12) will only be awarded if at the end of year 8 the planning shows that the realization will be ready at the latest in year 12.
