The scope of the contract is initially four (4) years with the option to extend it four (4) times by one (1) year each time. The contract therefore has a maximum term of eight (8) years.

The scope of this tender comprises plagiarism detection software capable of scanning submitted student work for possible plagiarism by students from:

1. Public (Internet) sources;
2. Academic sources (behind a paywall);
3. Student works previously submitted at TU Delft

The plagiarism detection software should be able to recognise passages and show similarities from the aforementioned source types while referring to the original source.
