NDW partnership

NDW is a public-public collaboration by and for road authorities. The goal of NDW is:

- Achieving efficiency through economies of scale, purchasing power, bundling of knowledge and preventing redundancy in the implementation between individual road authorities.
- Increasing social effects through cooperation between governments and between governments and market parties.
- Increasing the public focus towards road users by removing unnecessary barriers between road authorities and market parties.
- Strengthening government policy activities through better insight into traffic data.

NDW contributes to social effects in the field of mobility, open data and government efficiency.

The following organizations are currently partners of NDW: the State (RWS), all provinces, Metropolitan Region Rotterdam The Hague, Transport Region Amsterdam and the four large municipalities.
