The contracting authority has set the following key competences that correspond to experience in essential aspects of the contract:

- Ability to meet the demands from an engineering and scientific standpoint and in particular with regard to the application and interpretation of software-based statistical procedures in the field of energy technology and in the gas and electricity industry.
- Having practical experience in the implementation of an international efficiency benchmarking based on actual data, which can be supported for example through relevant references of other regulatory authorities.
- Ability to participate actively in the scientific discussions on efficiency benchmarkings, for example through presentations and publications.

Minimum requirements:

- The subject of the reference assignment must be comparable to the core competence in question;
 - The reference assignment must have been executed or completed within the three years prior to the closing date for submission of tenders.

If the Tenderer uses an assignment that is not yet fully complete, then only the completed results of the ongoing assignment can be submitted for reference purposes: projected results cannot be taken into consideration.

Assignments including one or more subcontractors can only be used as reference assignments if the subcontractor(s) in question will be involved in the fulfilment of the Contract and if the Tenderer can and will make use of the knowledge and experience of the subcontractor(s) in question during the fulfilment of the assignment.
