- contract 1: Replacement of the Coast Guard Radio Control system (RCS);

Contract 1 involves the Delivery of a RCS including Availability for five (5) years, with the right to extend the Availability twice for a period of five (5) years.

The delivery of the RCS entails:

- The Delivery of a RCS in compliance with all the requirements;
- The Delivery of documentation;
- The Delivery of training materials and training course(s);

- The Delivery of initial spare parts, components, specials tools and test equipment.

The entire Delivery of contract 1 must be before October 1st 2023. The entire RCS will be tested with a Site Acceptance Test (SAT).

As the RCS provides a mission-critical service for the user, the Contracting Authority has a need for an Availability per quarter of a Usage Year of 99,95% for the complete RCS system.

The responsibility that the Availability of the delivered RCS will be met, lies with the future supplier for a minimum term of five (5) years. Moreover, the future supplier is responsible for the Maintenance and operation, obsolescence, spare parts and technology updates in accordance with the defined performance requirements as specified in contract 1.

On request of the Contracting Authority the Contractor will perform modification Maintenance on the RCS.
