Technical cooperation on preventing coastal erosion and stimulating nature-based solutions on San Andres, Colombia

Purpose of the notification

The purpose of the market consultation is to assess interest of organizations that are capable of carrying out the assignment within the time frame and budget.

Extent and duration

The project will start as soon as possible (indication September) and must be completed by 31 December 2021 with no possibility for extension.

Budget indication

Maximum budget of € 100,000 excluding Dutch VAT of which an amount between 25-35k should be reserved for field work by a Colombian organization.

Goals and deliverables

Coastal erosion is a priority topic as part of the bilateral delta cooperation between Colombia and the Netherlands. As part of the Transition Facility instrument, and as a joint effort between the Government of Colombia (GoC) and the Government of the Netherlands (GoNL) a Master Plan Coastal Erosion was delivered in 2017. After the 2018 elections, the Plan Nacional de Desarrollo 2018-2022 has been developed under the leadership of DNP. PMEC is mentioned as part of the sections related to preservation of ecosystems and resilience to climate change effects. San Andres and Providencia are identified as priority areas in the PMEC. Due to the importance of this part of Colombia for both economic, environmental and political reasons, this assignment focusses on San Andres.

The scope of work consists of:

1. Indicative technical advice on local sand extraction in San Andres Island for beach nourishment and construction materials, while ensuring that adverse ecological effects of sand extraction are prevented and the limits of the coastal protected areas are respected.
2. Technical assessment of potential alternatives to prevent coastal erosion in San Andres island and illustrative advice, basic conceptual design(s) and indicative cost-benefit analyses on the most suitable solution, emphasizing nature-based solutions and including an assessment of the effects of hard infrastructure solutions

Procedure

Interested companies can be invited to this procedure. If you have demonstrable experience with similar projects, you can express your interest with us. You do not have to send documents; you only need to provide your name and address details or website link.
