TenneT operates as an international organisation, with stakeholders in both Germany and The Netherlands.

With the ongoing further professionalization of the privacy governance within the organisation, TenneT has the need for a Software-as-a-Service solution to support this professionalization to enable further growth. The solution must make the administration, registration and selections of diverse privacy matters possible as well as showing metrics and figures, to give a proper overview on where the organisation is at that moment standing with regards to its privacy compliance.

TenneT has structured data protection in a decentralized way. Business departments want to take their responsibility themselves and be in control of their processing activities, where the internal privacy organisation will support them with appropriate tooling, guidance, guidelines and such. This means that one or more privacy champions have been appointed for each

department. They are responsible for the data protection-relevant procedures and act as an interface between their department and the data protection team.

In order to be able to fulfil the applicable legal requirements and to give the business the opportunity to directly manage these tasks by themselves and also to reduce the coordination effort, TenneT wants to select and contract a solution which fulfils the above-mentioned requirements.

In TenneT's view such a Software-as-a-Service solution supports a way of working as follows:

- enables TenneT to be in control of the requirements as forthcoming from the GDPR;
- ability to maintain a register of processing activities;
- work with an operating model in which there are "super-users" (the privacy office) and "key-user" (the privacy champions). Key-users can only operate and maintain on assigned items in the solution, whereas the super-users have elevated rights;
- presence of work-flows, where tasks can be assigned (review processing activity) and versioning is incorporated (draft, final, etc);
- possibility for generation of reports to keep track on key privacy metrics;
- support in fulfilling data subject requests;
- work with a multi-language interface, at least incorporating Dutch, German and English;
- tool is built with up-to-date techniques, and gets updates on a regular base;
- information security is taken into account from the beginning on when developing the tool, ensuring the secure processing of all data involved;

The solution must be able to support both the German and Dutch TenneT companies, and the specialist party is required to deliver on-site support in both Arnhem (NL) and Bayreuth (GE) when TenneT requests.

TenneT expects experience and previous deployments in international companies, which preferably are involved in the distribution of gas or electricity.

The party has in-depth knowledge on the European privacy legislation and its national implementation laws.

As this is just a pre-announcement, no tender documentation will be enclosed.
