Implement a formal hot work permit system.

In order to help prevent a fire due to poor hot work practices, a formal permit system should be introduced to supervise all such operations (e.g., welding and cutting) performed by maintenance employees or outside contractors. All relevant staff should be informed accordingly.

2021002 Deep Fat Fryers - Protection

New	Physical Protection	Extinguishing systems	

Provide the deep fat fryers with an approved automatic fire extinguishing system.

The electric fed deep fat fryers in the sprinkler protected commercial kitchen on the ground floor and small kitchen on the first floor have no fire protection. The extraction duct of the hood travels through the high-rise building and can therefore cause a spread of fire in case of internal fire in this duct.

An interlock should be provided between the extinguishing system and the power supply of the fryers.
