This procurement concerns the delivery and maintenance of Counter Unmanned Aircraft Systems (acronym: C-UAS)

The Netherlands Armed Forces are looking for a modular capacity that include the following means and functions:

- Command and control

The term modular is used to describe that the system is expandable with new modules or that old modules easily can be replaced. This modular approach is facilitated by a robust and flexible command & control (C2), that enables communication between the system and its subsystems, sensors and effectors and that supports the operator in performing his/her tasks. The Maintenance Framework Agreement will have a period of performance of 10 (ten) years and will be concluded simultaneously with the Delivery Agreement on the understanding that both the Delivery and the Framework Agreement will be concluded with the same Tenderer.

The intention of the Contracting authority is to conduct maintenance as much as possible within the Defence Organisation itself. The Framework Agreement for maintenance is intended for maintenance activities on demand in case the maintenance capacity within the

Defence Organisation is not sufficient (quantitative/qualitative). The delivery (resupply), on demand, of spare parts and components and the provision of (repetition) training is also part of the Framework Agreement.
