During the initial year of production it is estimated that approx. 500.000 to 1 000 000 IP-addresses can be covered, expected to grow to 10 000 000 IP-addresses in the next years (including IPv6 space). In theory the number of IP addresses can go up to 100 000 000, although this participated as a high rate.

GÉANT likes to stress that all parties need to consider that the number of IP addresses can be considerably higher or lower than indicated above.

Amongst others, the indicated demand is dependent on the requirements of GÉANT's members and technical- and political developments.
