The objective of the project GERS is to have a floating functioning hydrogen station with a viable business model that can serve as an example within an innovation environment such as the RDM Dokhaven to the maritime industry.

The result of the project concerns:

- A functioning hydrogen refuelling station, that is suitable to refuel the Watertaxi Rotterdam gaseous hydrogen propelled vessels to begin with ((consumption 15kg/day, 350 bar (with the standard “IFSF connection”, maximum 30 min refuelling time with hydrogen quality 5.0).
- (Starting) location in the RDM Dokhaven – Rotterdam
- Provides green hydrogen (hydrogen produced through the electrolysis of water with 100% or near 100% renewable energy with close to zero greenhouse gas emissions (less than or equal to 1kg of CO₂e per kg H₂ taken as an average over a 12-month period)
- Possibility to scale modularly to larger tank capacity (pontoon size starting point is approximately 20x8m)
- GERS will be a floating installation moored by spuds, allowing for better safety measures and making relocation of the filling station possible.
- Hydrogen refueling services for a period of 10 years, with an optional extension of 5 years.
