

Enclosure 4: Statement of Joint and Several Liability, belonging to the European public tender for the vehicle fleet reinsurance of the Municipality of Amsterdam

In the event of a Combination, this statement must be completed and signed **in a legally valid way** for **each** Combination partner.

If a group has issued a declaration of joint and several liability in accordance with Book 2, Title 9, section 403 of the Burgerlijk Wetboek (Civil Code), a copy of this declaration will suffice and this Enclosure 4 does not need to be completed.
