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### VII.2) OTHER ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

SURF (and HEAnet) informs interested parties of its decision to provide for an additional possibility for admitting suppliers in the Dynamic Purchasing System (DPS) Video software regarding the Data Processing Agreement.

The current procedure for admitting suppliers is that an interested party has to accept upfront all conditions and procedures which are described in the Admission Guidelines. These conditions and procedures include the acceptance of one of the versions (bronze, silver or gold) of the applicable Data Processing Agreement.

In addition to this procedure a possibility will be introduced for an interested party to submit its own Data Processing Agreement including a compliance statement. This compliance statement will describe that the Data Processing Agreement of the interested party provides similar data protection as the Data Processing Agreement of SURF (at minimum the bronze version).

SURF will evaluate the compliance statement and decide on the basis of the compliance statement whether the Data Processing Agreement of the interested party is acceptable for admittance into the DPS. SURF will need a period of at most 30 calendar days (with a possibility to extend this period in exceptional circumstances) to evaluate the compliance statement. Interested party will accept that it will have to invest the time and resources required for executing the compliance statement.

Admitted suppliers (Candidates) may opt for the additional procedure but will be excluded for new Tender to safeguard a fair level playing field in relation to the Interested Parties. The compliance statement documents are available on Tendering platform MerCell via Tab 'Attachments'.

This change in procedure enters into force after a standstill period of 20 calendar days for interested parties to raise an objection. This period ends on May 26th, 2022. After the standstill period, the new procedure will be enforced.
