Starting 2023 each year all European paying agencies have to monitor area based schemes funded by the Common Agricultural Policy budget. This includes crop classification, detection of mowing events and other agricultural activities. This particular job requires storing and processing huge amounts of data. NEA is looking for a technical partner to help setup an AMS cloud environment and running and creating markers to monitor agricultural activities.

The assignment entails the following components:

- Hosting: Environment for running algorithms and having all data available;
- Production: Activities related to regular AMS production;
- Development: Activities related to development of new markers and functionalities;

- Data: Activities related to buying and processing (commercial) satellite data;
- Archive: Activities related to archiving of production data according to the requirements set by the European Commission.
