Air Traffic Control The Netherlands (ATC-NL) and Frequentis AG jointly seek your valued advice in order to prepare a sourcing strategy for high brightness touch screens that are suitable and match the set requirements. For this purpose ATC-NL has published this market consultation on Tenders European Daily (TED).

ATC-NL has installed at their Schiphol air traffic control towers the SmartStrips system from Frequentis. This Electronic Flight Strip System (EFSS) uses touch screens to display flight strips and interact with these flight strips. Each flight strip is in general associated with an aircraft manoeuvring on the ground or within the control area for that airport. The current touch screens reach their end of life and need to be replaced in due time.
