

House Rules

To ensure the safety, livability and manageability of the accommodations, the municipality of Smallerland applies house rules.

Living space and living environment

- It's not permitted to make any changes in, to or around the living area of the accommodation's premises or to the furniture. It is not permitted to put your own furniture or furnishings (such as curtains/wall hangings etc.) in the accommodation's premises.
- Please keep your room tidy and clean.
- You and your fellow residents can use the communal living area. Everyone is jointly responsible for keeping the entire accommodation clean and livable, including the communal living areas and the immediate surroundings.
- **Parents are responsible for their own children.**



Discrimination, intimidation and violence

The general rule of the municipality of Smallerland is that during your stay in the accommodation you must comply with the laws and regulations of Dutch society. Discrimination, intimidation and violence is not allowed and punishable by Dutch law.



Absence/obligation to report

You may be absent for a maximum of 24 hours without reporting this. In the event of unauthorized and/or unannounced absence, the municipality has the right to immediately terminate the living allowance and access to the shelter. You may be absent for a maximum of 5 days by notifying the staff at the reception location. You then fill in an absence form together with the employee of the reception location. If you don't do this your absence will be seen as unannounced.

Visitors

Visitors from outside the accommodation premises, are not allowed to enter the accommodation and premises. Please meet your visitors outside the location.



Drugs, alcohol, weapons, illegal trade

Illegal occupation, use and/or trade of drugs and weapons or other illegal commercial activities are prohibited. Public drunkenness is not permitted.



Noise nuisance

Please show consideration for your fellow residents and neighbors and do not cause any inconvenience or nuisance. From 22:00 until 07:00 it should be quiet.



Violation of privacy

- Without permission, it is forbidden to make video and sound recordings of fellow residents, staff members and other within the confines of the accommodation premises of fellow residents, staff members and others present at the premises.
- The use of hidden cameras is expressly forbidden.
- The publication or other sharing of recordings is not permitted without the permission of those involved.



Fire regulations

- The following fire regulations must always be complied with:
- The preparation of food is not permitted outside the areas designated by the municipality for this purpose.
- The use of unsafe electrical equipment or the use of electrical equipment that is not fireproof is not permitted.
- Limit the use of extension cords and power strips. It is not allowed to switch multiple sockets.
- Blocking escape routes, for instance by parking strollers or pushchairs is not permitted.
- Always remove old lint from the dryer filter before use. Operating a dirty dryer may cause a fire.
- Smoking is not permitted in your own living quarters nor in other parts of the building.
- Open fire (candles, incense, etc.) is not permitted.
- If the fire alarm sounds, please, immediately leave the building and wait outside for instructions from the staff.
- It is forbidden to make any changes or to damage fire protection devices.
- For example it is forbidden to:
 - Tape shut or otherwise disable a fire alarm.
 - Dismantle a door closer or block a self-closing fire door to prevent it from closing.
 - Use fire extinguishers for other purposes than fighting fires.
