Dear Sir or Madam,

You are eligible for shelter or housing at one of the locations facilitated by the Smallerland Municipality. This document describes your rights and obligations. They apply during your entire stay in this shelter, regardless of which of the locations you stay at.

By signing this document, you agree to its contents and undertake to abide by it. Failure to comply with your obligations may result in termination of your stay at our shelter locations.

Health check

If the municipal health service sees a reason to invite you for a medical examination or to place you in quarantine or isolation (e.g. due to possibly having TB or Covid-19), you are obliged to cooperate.

Your rights

If you make use of the shelter, under certain conditions, you are entitled to:

1. Accommodation.
2. A financial allowance (if applicable within the shelter facility and you have no other income).
3. Reimbursement of medical expenses and civil liability insurance.
4. In special situations, an allowance for costs that are exceptional and necessary.
5. Education for children younger than 18 years of age.
6. Submission of complaints about fellow residents, facilities or staff members.
7. A contact person from the municipality.
8. Termination of the shelter if you wish.

Your obligations

In return for your rights, you have obligations:

1. You are obliged to comply with Dutch law.
2. You are obliged to observe the house rules and the visitors' regulations of the shelter location. You will be given the house rules on the day of your arrival and you can view them at each location. The visitor rules are posted at the entrance to each location.
3. You are obliged to allow municipal employees and specifically appointed officials access to your room for the mandatory room inspection.
4. You are obliged to cooperate with a check of your bag or suitcase if there are specific indications that you have breached your obligations or the house rules.
5. You are obliged to participate in the mandatory interviews and programme components to which you are invited during your stay in the Netherlands or at the municipality's shelter location.
6. You are obliged to comply with the duty to report and to register at the shelter location.
7. You are obliged to use the accommodation provided by the municipality during your stay. It is not permitted to stay more than one night outside the shelter location without the consent of the municipality.
8. You are obliged to follow the instructions of the municipality employees and officials engaged by the municipality.
9. You are obliged to return undamaged any goods provided by the municipality when you leave the shelter location. If goods or parts of goods are missing or damaged, the municipality may charge you for the damage or deduct it from your financial allowance.
10. You are obliged to inform the municipality immediately if your financial situation changes, for example if you receive income from work or if you have your own money (assets).
