The Dutch Metropolitan Innovations (DMI-) ecosystem serves the disciplines mobility, public space, energy, ecology and housing in the Netherlands utilizing new solutions of the digital world. DMI is partially made possible by the Dutch National Growth Fund. In the coming years, the Ministry of Infrastructure and Water Management, in collaboration with other public entities, shall regularly award so-called innovation, research and development assignments to private organizations that are, or will become participants in the DMI-ecosystem. The Ministry of Infrastructure and Water Management shall procure these assignments also on behalf of all government organizations that are currently participants in the DMI ecosystem or will become participants in the near future. Private organizations (both nonprofit and profit) are free to join as a Participant in the DMI Ecosystem as long as there are no legal restrictions (fraud e.g.). Only private entities that have become a participant to DMI and paid the mandatory financial contribution shall be eligible for research and development offerings and contracts. The assignments envisaged, as a consequence of combining the target areas mobility, public space, energy, ecology, construction and housing, cover a broad spectrum. Ranging from new IT-solutions and platforms to financial and investment strategies, developing urban strategies, analysis and planning, reverse engineering and so forth.

The (1) exact scope of each individual assignment, (2) the applicable requirements thereof (eligibility, contract type, service levels and so forth) and (3) the on-target appraisal methodology will be tailored made prior to making a request for proposal or an invitation to tender available within the DMI-community.
