Purpose and intended scope of the project

Purpose of the assignment is to manage, organise and facilitate the draft writing of the energy policy review (2018) in close cooperation with the beneficiary partner which is the Ministry of Energy and Petroleum (MoEP) and other development partners i.e. World Bank, EU Delegation in Kenya, etc., including the Netherlands Embassy in Nairobi.

The scope of the project will be stage III of the policy review process which is focussed on the writing of a new draft Energy Policy text, based on the outcomes on the meetings of the sub-sector working groups. Stage III will consist of meetings with the relevant stake holders, like general public, private sector, industry players and government officials, and bringing all the input together in one draft text. After legal checks the draft text of the Energy Policy Review will be prepared for the MoEP in order to draw up a final policy document.

The Policy review process started last year with an inception period support of the EU Delegation in Kenya. Currently stage II of the policy review is taking place with several ongoing sub-sector working groups meetings that will review the policy.

Goals and deliverables

The goal of the assignment is to support the Kenyan government in reviewing the Kenyan Energy Policy of 2018 while taking into account several internal and external challenges and opportunities such as promoting use of renewable energy, energy access challenges, productive use of energy, enhancing energy efficiency, new developments in e-cooking and e-mobility, etc.. Main deliverable of the project will be the new draft Energy Policy text.
