The sensors are including cables and accessory for aligning to direction north. 3rd line maintenance, which involves advanced technical support and specialized knowledge, is expected to incur varying costs depending on factors such as the price of spare parts and the level of service required. Costs for training are estimated at € 15.000,-. The exact value depends on what the Tenderer offers.
