Dear Sir or Madam,

With this letter, we inform you of a material modification in the tender for the IPScore Automated System, as originally published on 28 May 2025. This modification concerns both the content of the tender documents and the timetable of the procedure.

1. Substantive Modification

During the preparation of answers to submitted questions, it was identified that certain rules regarding ISO 27001 were either incorrect or not properly placed:

Lot 1 – Deleted Requirements:

Rule	Description	Status
113	Compliance	Deleted: “It is guaranteed that Erasmus MC with this tender can comply with relevant regulatory requirements concerning information security and protection of personal identifiable data, including GDPR and ISO 27001.”
114	ISO 27001 & Dutch NEN7510:2011	Deleted: “The system is demonstrably in compliance with generally accepted standards for IT security, such as ISO 27001 and the Dutch NEN7510:2011.”
127	ISO 27001 compliance	Deleted: “The tenderer is demonstrably in compliance with the generally accepted standard for IT security, ISO 27001.”

Lot 3 – Deleted Requirement:

Rule	Description
20	ISO 27001 compliance: The tenderer is demonstrably in compliance with the generally accepted standard for IT security, ISO 27001.

Added to Lot 1 –Wishes:

With this rectification, the following desirable requirement has been added to Lot 1: The tenderer is ISO 27001 certified, or demonstrably operates in accordance with the requirements of the ISO/IEC 27001 standard for information security.

These modifications constitute a material change within the meaning of Article 2.28 of the Dutch Public Procurement Act 2012. To ensure transparency and equal treatment, the procurement procedure is effectively restarted from this point, without withdrawing the original publication.

The changes have been incorporated into the updated Terms of Reference/Specifications (PvE/PvW). Consequently, Section 5.2.2.2 of the Tender Guideline is now obsolete.

2. Next Steps and Answers to Questions

Due to this material modification, the tender process is restarted. A new Questions & Answers period will apply as follows:

- Questions submitted by 25 September 2025 will be answered on 07 October 2025.
- Questions submitted by 21 October 2025 will be answered on 30 October 2025.

3. Revised Timeline – Full Procedure

- Completion of Questions & Answers period: 30 October 2025
- Deadline for submission of tenders: 21 November 2025, 15:00 CET

4. Transparency and Legal Certainty

This restart of the procurement procedure ensures full transparency, legal certainty, and equal access to the contract. By communicating the revised evaluation structure in a timely manner and providing sufficient periods for additional questions and submissions, we comply with the obligations under the Dutch Public Procurement Act 2012.
