Implementation of Framework Agreement, ref. 202409075

FURTHER AGREEMENT REGARDING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CORE TEAM, ref. 202409075A

Amended after Memorandum of Information (dd. 18-06-2025)

The undersigned:

1. The State of the Netherlands, which has its seat in The Hague, represented by the Minister Climate Policy and Green Growth, legally represented in this matter by

hereinafter referred to as the Contracting Authority,

and

hereinafter referred to as the Contractor,

WHEREAS:

1. The Contracting Authority and the Contractor concluded a Framework Agreement on [date] relating to the implementation of activities in the area of a Technical Support Organisation, ref. 202409075, hereafter referred to as 'the Framework Agreement', which applies to all contracts for the performance of Services that the Contracting Authority awards during the term of the Framework Agreement;
2. As part of the Tender document [ref. 202409075], the Contracting Authority asked Tenderers to submit a Quotation for the establishment of a Core Team as part of their Tender.
3. The Contractor submitted a Tender including a proposed Core Team , ref. ..., to the Contracting Authority on [date].
4. The Contractor's Tender, containing a proposed Core Team , was judged to offer the best price-quality ratio and subsequently Contractor was awarded the Framework Agreement and the Further Agreement for the establishment of a Core Team .
5. This Further Agreement lays down the specific conditions applicable to the performance by the Contractor of the establishment of a Core Team .



AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Applicable conditions

- 1.1 This Further Agreement is governed by the provisions of the Framework Agreement, in so far as this Contract does not depart from it. The terms written with initial capitals in this Further Agreement are defined in the Framework Agreement. The term 'Contract' in the ARVODI 2018 is to be read as 'Further Agreement' for the purpose of this Contract.
- 1.2 The conditions included in the Quotation (including price indexation, discounts and guarantees) do not apply in so far as they are less favourable for the Contracting Authority than those included the Framework Agreement.

2. Object of the Further Agreement

- 2.1 The Contracting Authority hereby commissions the Contractor to establish and put at the disposal of Contracting Authority, a Core Team, which commission the Contracting Authority hereby accepts, in so far as this Further Agreement does not depart from it.
- 2.2 The following documents together form the Further Agreement. In the event of inconsistencies, a higher ranked document takes precedence over a lower ranked document:
- 1 this document;
 - 2 the Framework Agreement (ref. 202409075) including attachments dated [date];
 - 3 the Tender Document (ref. 202409075) including attachments dated [date];
 - 4 the ARVODI 2018;
 5. the Tender in response to the European call for tenders with reference 202409075 and date xx.

3. Personnel

- 3.1 The Contractor shall deploy for the performance of the Task Order specified in the Tender document [ref. 202409075] the following personnel, indicating job profile/level:

- 3.2 The activities of the Core Team, mentioned in article 3.1, are understood to at least involve:
- 3.2.1 The activities listed under 2.5.4 of the Tender Document.
- 3.2.2 The rendering of reactive general advice and/or support within the TSO scope, as contained in subsection 2.5 of the Tender document, to Contracting Authority following queries or proposals of Contracting Authority staff.



- 3.3 Core Team members must have a valid VOG within 2 months, provided they can show proof of a VOG application at the start of the Further Agreement. Should a Core Team member fail to acquire a VOG within two months, Contractor must offer a placement staff member of similar competency and experience.

4. Duration

- 4.1 This Further Agreement has an initial contract period of one (1) year starting from <<date>> and ending <<date>>. This Further Agreement has an option to extend, to be exercised unilaterally by the Contracting Authority, under the same conditions, with four (4) times a maximum period of one (1) year. The total duration of the Further Agreement is therefore maximum five years including extension options.
- 4.2 At least three months before the expiration of this Further Agreement contract period, Contracting Authority will communicate to Contractor whether Contracting Authority will extend the Further Agreement, submit a new Request for Quotation or let the Further Agreement expire without succeeding Agreement.

5. Place and time of work

- 5.1 The hours worked locally ex updated requirement 3.2.2 of the Tender Document will be performed at the offices of The Ministry of Climate Policy and Green Growth at Bezuidenhoutseweg 73, The Hague. Should the execution of article 7.1 of the Framework Agreement be effected, the work come to be performed at the, to be defined, offices of NEO NL.
- 5.2 The work of the entire Core Team, mentioned in article 3.1, shall be performed from Monday to Friday with each Core Team member for a maximum of 9 hours per day and 40 hours per week.
- 5.3 Parties can agree to temporarily deviate from 5.2, if such is required by specific, temporary and significant circumstances.

6. Financial provisions

- 6.1 The Contractor will perform the Task Order to be provided under this Further Agreement for a price based on actual time worked, using the rates referred to the Tender in response to the European call for tenders with reference 202409075 and date xx.
- 6.2 Payment will be made on receipt and approval of an monthly submitted invoice.
- 6.2.1 **For companies established in the Netherlands only:**

Invoices must be sent in one of the three following ways:

If you create an e-invoice via the invoicing portal, you only need to enter the order number in the field "Reference or order number". Sending more information in the field "Reference or order number" can lead to problems in the automatic acceptance and processing of the invoice.

When your invoice is not submitted in accordance with these requirements, it will not be processed or the payment term will be extended.

6.3 In their invoice, Contractor must clearly indicate what part of the total costs are wage costs, separate from other costs as described in the list of requirement 3.5.2 of the Tender Document, alongside the amount of working hours worked at Contracting Authority premises.

7. Contacts and reports

7.1 For the purpose of this Further Agreement, the Contracting Authority's contact is ... and the Contractor's contact is The contacts will hold consultations on the Contractor's implementation of the work as frequently as the Contracting Authority demands, and at least once per three months.

7.2 Notwithstanding the provisions of article 10.2 of the ARVODI 2018, the contacts cannot make legally binding agreements on the Parties' behalf.
