

WHY

Sustainability is an urgent theme and, given its function in society, LVNL wants to take responsibility for creating a sustainable world of the future. For that reason LVNL has translated the subject of sustainability into the sustainable vision entitled '**enabling smart and sustainable aviation together**'. In doing so the focus of the sustainability programme is on making company processes sustainable on the basis of three concepts: **climate**, **circular** and **health & social**. Realistic (interim) targets have been set for 2030 on the way to creating a sustainable LVNL. The overarching goal is that we make LVNL's products, services and processes - and with that the conduct of employees - more sustainable.

Socially Responsible Procurement (SRP) is, in this respect, an essential instrument for accelerating the process of making the organisation sustainable. All tenders will therefore include **sustainability criteria** (requirements and/or award criteria) based on the 3 concepts and **we are going to challenge the market** to support us in achieving our goals by proactively translating this into the product and/or the service.



As far as LVNL is concerned the definition of sustainability links up with the definition as formulated by the United Nations' World Commission on Environment and Development in the report entitled 'Our Common Future': *'Sustainable development is development that meets the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs.'*

OBJECTIVES FOR 2030



Climate

- **Carbon footprint:** we are going to reduce our footprint by 50% compared to 2017, with a minimum of compensation.
- **Energy:** our aim is to be energy neutral.
- **Mobility:** we are going to reduce the impact of mobility by 20% compared to 2017.



Circular

- **R-ladder:** we are going to apply the hierarchy of the circular R-ladder and are going to give products a new life in order to optimise their economic life.
- **Reuse unless:** we are always going to reuse raw and other materials, unless this is impossible.
- **Raw material use:** we are going to reduce our waste by 50% compared to 2017.



Health & Social

- **Chain responsibility / International social conditions:** we are going to map out our own chain.
- **A diverse and inclusive working environment:** we are going to create a safe and enjoyable working environment for everyone. Tenders will include a Social Return On Investment (SROI) element if this is appropriate for the assignment.
- **Healthy working environment:** we are going to offer a healthy and enjoyable working environment.
- **Sustainable behaviour:** we are going to encourage sustainable behaviour through communication and education.
