

MARKET CONSULTATION AUTOMATIC WASTE COLLECTION SYSTEM

MUNICIPALITY OF RIJSWIJK

Dear participant,

The Municipality of Rijswijk is currently (re)developing three densely built high-rise urban areas. In these neighborhoods, traditional methods of waste collection may pose significant challenges. To address these issues, the Municipality is considering the use of an Automatic Waste Collection System (AWCS). A feasibility study has shown that an AWCS could be a viable solution for these projects. However, no final decision has yet been made regarding the implementation of one or more of these systems in the identified areas.

Before presenting the final plans to the Municipal Council for approval (the go-ahead decision), the Municipality wishes to contact companies that provide such systems (or significant parts thereof). This will allow the Municipality to gather relevant information and insights prior to making a definitive choice.

Furthermore, it is essential that our requirements within the tendering process align with current market offerings. For this reason, we have organised this market consultation. We kindly invite you to share your knowledge, experience, and perspectives by responding to several questions and actively participating in this consultation.

Structure of The Documents

This invitation is accompanied with two documents:

- Part A – Introduction (pdf-file): This first section details the ongoing development projects, the current status of decision-making, and the procedure and planning for this market consultation.
- Part B – Questionnaire (word-file): The second part contains the questions the Municipality would like answered. These questions are both technical and organizational in nature. Some are important for the decision-making process, while others are particularly relevant for the tender and project phases.
