Short summary of the meeting

During the meeting, a brief overview and background information was provided regarding the partnership **Geothermie Amsterdam–Amstelveen 1**. The slides presented during the meeting are published as part of these minutes.

A detailed explanation of the selection procedure was provided, as it is expected that not all parties are familiar with this procedure. Please note that the procedure is very strict. Errors may lead to exclusion of (parts of) the Request to Participate or Tender from evaluation or even exclusion of a party from submitting a tender.

During the **Request to Participate Phase**, it is possible to submit questions (through TenderNed) to the Contracting Authority **until 14:00 hours on 11 March 2026**.

Questions and answers

Parties were given the opportunity to ask questions. The questions and answers are listed below.

Several (technical) questions were raised. It was indicated that these questions should be submitted via TenderNed, after which a written response will be provided.

Question 1:

Is it possible to ask questions regarding the next phases of the tender, or only regarding the selection phase?

Answer:

Any questions may be submitted.

Question 2:

What did you mean when you explained about questions that have a commercial interest? Can you give an example of such a question?

Answer:

An example of a question with a commercial interest could be a question related to financial arrangements, cost allocation, risk allocation, or other contractual conditions that may influence the commercial position of the parties. Such questions may be submitted and answered individually via TenderNed. Please provide a clear justification of the commercial interest when submitting such a question.

Question 3:

Will you be able to provide an overview of the upfront costs (*voorloopkosten*)?

Answer:

These costs are included in **Appendix 3 of the Partnership Agreement**, which has been published on 22 February 2026.

Question 4:

Does the timeline for selecting the final locations for the geothermal sources align with the timeline of the current exploration permit area (the permit expires on 1 January 2029)? Is it feasible to determine a final location before that date?

Answer:

We have not yet identified any location(s), initial preparatory investigations are ongoing. At present, we expect that selecting the final locations will fit within the permit duration; identifying the specific locations and defining the schedule is part of the development phase under the Partnership Agreement.

Question 5:

Will the 3D seismic data be ready for interpretation in October 2026?

Answer:

The final processed products are currently expected to be available by the end of 2026.
