### II.4) SHORT DESCRIPTION OF NATURE AND QUANTITY OR VALUE OF SUPPLIES OR SERVICES

A part of the lighting of the Dutch, Danish and Flemish national road networks needs to be replaced because the end of the lifecycle for these products has been reached. This is a significant investment and the authorities lack financial resources to replace all the lighting at once. Therefore, the replacement will be executed in phases. To increase the feasibility the three road authorities have chosen to cooperate in order to find lighting solutions which offer, taking the entire life cycle costs into consideration, better value for money. This means that not only is the initial purchase price of importance, but factors such as maintenance costs, energy consumption etcetera also need to be regarded. The road authorities are considering economization through the introduction of LED (lower energy consumption and longer life span, better light quality), including long-term maintenance or other creative contracting approaches, for instance the possibility of market parties not only supplying and installing the lighting but also taking care of the maintenance. Furthermore, the road authorities are considering the possibility of pre financing by the road authorities or the market.

The Dutch, Danish and Flemish road authorities are organizing two market consultations to ascertain the state of the market with regard to low life cycle cost lighting and to offer market parties the opportunity to present concrete solutions and input on their feasibility.

The first round of market consultations will be held June 28, 2016, at 10:00 AM at Schiphol Airport, Amsterdam the Netherlands. The market consultation will entail presentations and a Q&A plenary dialogue session. The plenary part of the market consultation will end at

12.30. Afterwards the road authorities invite you to lunch. After lunch parties are offered the opportunity to talk to the road authorities in one-on-one dialogues. If parties are not able to join on location, the road authorities invite all interested parties to join via webinar. The aim of the first round is to inform the market parties about the challenges in road lighting and replacement faced by the Netherlands, Denmark and Flanders and to discuss these challenges. Another topic is to check how the challenges faced by the road authorities can be brought to the market in the best way. How can the challenges by the road authorities be aligned with the challenges faced by industry.

The second market consultation is scheduled to be held on September 14, 2016, at Schiphol Airport, Amsterdam the Netherlands. The objective of this second market consultation is to offer interested market parties the opportunity to propose their ideas and possible solutions and to check the interest of market parties for tenders regarding lighting replacement.
