Can the Kadaster give an indication as to how many old-fashioned lists there are and whether they cover the entire scope of the analogue field sketches?	There is no reliable information about the number of old-fashioned lists. We could generate this from our archive but since this has never been done before it is too complicated for the moment. However, the amount is far less than the amount of the field sketches, an estimation varies from 20.000 to 150.000. This main part of these lists has been made in the period between 1930 and 1980 and not for every part of the Netherlands. So there are areas with analogue field sketches without a usable relation to control points. However, this will be our problem and is out of scope of this market survey.
