Justification (in Dutch only)

De onderbouwing voor het creëren van een mogelijkheid tot overschrijding van de maximale termijn heeft zowel economische als technische redenen. Gelet op de vervangingscyclus van de apparatuur, wordt de apparatuur in het algemeen langer gebruikt dan vier jaar: gemiddeld naar acht jaar volgt er een nieuwe definitiefase, voordat een volgend project de overgang naar weer nieuwere apparatuur in kan zetten. De apparatuur zal dan ook minimaal tien jaar nodig zijn, waarbij gedurende die tijd additionele apparatuur aangeschaft moet kunnen worden en er een jaar moet worden bij gerekend waarin een migratie kan worden gedaan. Tevens kost

de initiële uitrol van de apparatuur een periode, de periode voorafgaand aan het in productie nemen van een nieuw apparaat duurt gemiddeld een half jaar tot een jaar.

De reden van het langere gebruik is gelegen in de investeringen die zijn gedaan met de aanschaf van de apparatuur. Van belang daarbij is dat de aan te schaffen apparatuur in beginsel niet met die van andere leveranciers te combineren is. Indien dus eenmaal wordt gekozen voor een bepaalde technologie, dan dient SURFnet naar verwachting voor acht tot tien jaar met de leverancier van die technologie samen te kunnen werken. Overigens is de verwachting dat SURFnet vanaf het achtste gebruiksjaar nog slechts zeer beperkte hoeveelheden apparatuur zal bestellen voor vervanging en nieuwe aansluitingen.

SURFnet is searching for a Partner that can provide a solution for the SURFnet8 photonic layer. The aim of the Tender Procedure is to award a Contract to a Partner that can provide the requested hardware, software and support.

For the next generations of the SURFnet network, SURFnet requires a new photonic layer. This Tender aims to renew the bandwidth providing photonic layer, which is used for SURFnet's domestic services and potentially the Cross Border Fiber (CBF) systems.

The scope of the Contract for delivering the SURFnet8 photonic layer consists of;

1. Hardware, i.e. the physical equipment including installation related materials;
2. Software and licenses (including software interfaces (APIs)) for planning, performance monitoring, troubleshooting, fault detection, provisioning, security and accounting, automation, and programmability;
3. Layer 0 and layer 1 control plane functionality;
4. Training and periodic training sessions for current staff and staff to be hired in the future, and external personnel;
5. A migration scenario from our existing Ciena CPL and DWDM layer to a new solution. This may include field service support and the provision of temporary hardware;
6. High level design activities for migration, introduction of new features or equipment, and complex changes;
7. M&S (Maintenance and Support). SURFnet will stock its own spares;
8. Installation and de-installation procedures for equipment and software;
9. Delivery and setup of a test bed.
